

Bruning Dam Rifle Target and Trap Shoot Range

In 2012m the NRD investigated the possibility of developing a rifle target range behind the Bruning Dam in cooperation with the Game and Parks Commission. The Commission had reserved money to develop several sites around the state and the Bruning site was selected as a possibility. Unfortunately, the G & P funds were diverted to other needs and the program was never pursued. The time might be right for development of such an area. Here is the early layout and evaluation of the site.

Residences within 2 miles of the site. The rifle range was designed to shoot north with the dam as a secondary backstop for bullets. The area immediately east of the rifle range could be developed as a trap shooting area.
