<u>Discussion/Action on Truck Bids:</u> Bids were let for the purchase of a new truck; three bids were received. <u>MOTION #7 – Wiedel moved, seconded by Ochsner to accept the bid from Kenesaw Motors to purchase a Ford F-150 pickup in the amount of \$44,693.</u> Carried by roll call vote – 12 yes votes.

<u>Review/Approve Long Range Implementation Plan</u>: The updated Long Range Implementation Plan was presented. Action to approve the Plan will be taken at the November meeting.

The Water Resources Committee met prior to the regular meeting.

<u>Discussion/Action on Barry Renz Transfer Request:</u> Renz requested a transfer in March, 2024, action on the variance was delayed until this fall. Additional information will be presented at the November meeting.

<u>Discussion/Action on Michael Walters Approved Well Permit and Legal Validity of the Well Permit if the Property is Sold Prior to Drilling a Well:</u> Discussion was held with legal counsel on the validity of a well permit transferring to a new owner. No action was taken.

<u>Discussion/Action on the Creation/Expansion of a New Water Quality Sub-Area:</u> Goeschel presented data on a proposed Bruning Sub-Area expansion. <u>MOTION #8 – Hoffman moved, seconded by Shaw to approve the creation of a new sub-Area east of Bruning and schedule a public hearing to be held November 12. Carried by roll call vote – 12 yes votes.</u>

<u>Discussion/Action on a Contract with DNR for Nitrogen Reduction Incentive Act Funding:</u> The district is eligible to receive funding to work with producers to reduce nitrogen. <u>MOTION # 9 – Hoffman moved, seconded by Ochsner to approve the contract Between the State of Nebraska Department of Natural Resources and the Little Blue NRD for Nitrogen Reduction Incentive Act Funding and authorize its signature. Carried by roll call vote – 12 yes votes.</u>

Update on Joint IMP Meeting: No update was provided.

Other Business: There was no other business.

The Projects and Planning Committee met prior to the regular meeting.

MOTION # 11 – Hoffman moved, seconded by Schroer to come out of Executive Session at 8:14 p.m. Wiedel noted no legal action was taken during the closed session.
