Von Spreckelsen called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. at NRD Board Room in Davenport.

1. Big Allis Solar Project – Clay County

Ikkala, Seltzer, Anderson, and Spaeth gave an overview of the Big Allis Solar Project being built in Clay county. Clay county wants the NRD to regulate erosion and sediment control around the project. It was discussed the NRD cannot regulate such things but can provide guidance with the help of the NRCS. It was suggested to send a letter to Clay county zoning about changing the wording after the February board meeting. **A motion was made by Glenn, it was seconded by Hoffman, and unanimously approved striking ‘The NRD would be responsible for overseeing and monitoring the land and/or waterways to avoid hazards with soil erosion and water drainage,’ from the requirements.**

2. Low-Key Famous Anti-Bullying Festival at Lonestar

Aulando Frazier presented on hosting an anti-bullying festival (Low-Key Famous) at Lonestar Recreation Area. It would include music performances, video game tournaments, obstacle course challenges, and other activities. It was discussed that our facility could not handle the amount of people and traffic that they were planning on. **No action was taken. Mr. Frazier chose to withdraw his Special Permit Application**

3. Other Business

Goeschel discussed that the game warden suggested that we put a sign at the entrance of Roseland Lake for ‘no target shooting.’
